





Participation Rules "Corremos Por La Vida" 2017

Date: September 3rd 2017

Place: Sky Costanera, North corner of Costanera Center Assembly Area: Nueva Tobalaba, in front of Hard Rock Cafe

Finish line: 60th Floor, Edificio Costanera

The event will be held between 8 AM and 2 PM, climbing starts at 8:30 AM

700 places available for participants

Eligibility

The Event is open to Firefighters only. International competitors must be currently employed in a recognized brigade in the role of Firefighter, and on request be able to supply proof of employment as such. Minimum age for entry is 18 years on the day of entry.

Volunteer Firefighters are also eligible to compete providing that they are active in the role of a firefighter at the time of the event.

Firefighters must be fully fit to compete.

Complete the registration form online.

Must accept the waiver and hand it in when acquiring their participant kit.

Participants will be divided by age and gender categories:

- Male and female
- Further subdivided in age categories: 18 29, 30 39, 40 49, 50 59 and 60+

Registration:

Will be available in www.heroesdecorazon.cl between July 24th and August 24th, and will be subject to availability. There is a registration fee of 10,000 CLP, which will be entirely donated to "Corporación del Trasplante" www.trasplante.cl. Registration will only be valid once payment is accepted. The registration includes the participant's kit.

Kit:

A participant kit will be available at Santiago Fire Department Headquarters (Santo Domingo 978) on:

- Friday September 1st from 6PM to 9PM.
- Saturday September 2nd from 3PM to 7PM.

Kits will not be available on the day of the event.

The kit will include the official event t-shirt, the assigned number and a timing chip.

Uniform:

All participants must wear Turnout coat, pants and helmets, that must meet NFPA or EN standards on protective ensemble for structural firefighting. Gloves and hoods are optional.

SCBA will be supplied by the event organizers, on the day of the event.

Rules:

- All participants will be divided into groups of 20 which will be published in <u>www.heroesdecorazon.cl</u> 48 hours before the event. Each group will be assigned a starting time.
- Participants must be at the starting area 30 minutes before their assigned group starting time.
- Every participant must begin and end the climb with the SCBA connected to have an official time.
- An ID with a photograph must be available at all times.
- The event t-shirt, number and chip must be worn at all times.
- Access to the Tower is forbidden at any other time except during the climb. No entry to the mall next door while in uniform.
- No alcohol or drugs at the event.
- Registration fees are final and will not be returned.
- All finishers will receive a medal.

Awards Ceremony:

An awards ceremony will be held after all the participants have concluded their climb. The fastest three times of each category will receive a special recognition.
